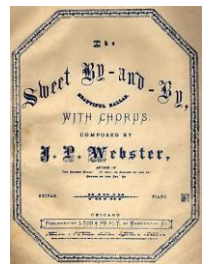


### **East Troy Electric Railroad & Museum.**
